In this past year we've studied and prayed and given much thought as what the church does together when we gather on Sundays.

Here's what has come to us so far.

Our worship on Sundays will include:

- The reading, preaching/teaching of the breathed-out and living Word of God that transforms our lives as it is obeyed
- Receiving of the bread and the cup in remembrance of Jesus
- Singing together of new songs, hymns, and enduring songs that are (a) God-focused and gospel-saturated,
 (b) musically beautiful, (c) simple to sing, and (d) give voice to our gratitude and praise of God
- Reciting of creeds and confessions that declare our convictions

Our worship on Sundays will include:

- Prayers of the people that thank God and ask for his provision in all things
- Sharing of God-stories that praise God for his experienced faithfulness
- Giving of our tithes and offerings to express our gratitude and trust in God's provision
- Spurring each other on in our faith and practice through the interaction of the Coffee and Life Connection questions
- Giving of the blessing that declares the goodness of God

God's word says that above all things we are to love God, to be responsive to him, to delight in him, to appreciate his wisdom and power, and in all things to trust and obey him.

The last night of his life Jesus told his disciples...






Remember the quote we shared with you last Sunday... made by CS Lewis?

This long obedience in the same direction is something we pursue together.



"The making of a disciple involves an intentional relationship in which we walk alongside other disciples in order to encourage, equip and challenge one another to grow towards maturity in Christ."




What the elders and deacons are proposing to the church...is that we be intentional in building our lives in Christ.

To that end we are embarking on a a year long discipling journey.




Discipleship Essential is a study done with two or three others.














